



Scholarship Application Guidelines and Criteria for the Skating Club of Natick

2016 – 2017 academic year

The Board of Directors of the Skating Club of Natick is pleased to announce application guidelines for its Annual Scholarship Award Program.

1. Students who have been accepted to and/or are currently attending a 2-year or 4-year college are eligible to apply.
2. Applicants may only be awarded a scholarship from the Skating Club of Natick one time.
3. Applicant must be a USFS eligible skater.
4. Applicant must be a current member in good standing of the Skating Club of Natick for a minimum of four (4) years and represent the Skating Club of Natick in all USFS activities.
5. Applicant must have demonstrated active participation in the Skating Club of Natick in each of the four (4) most recent years of membership. Examples of active participation include, but are not limited to, participation in testing, competing, and assistance at group lessons.
6. Applicant must volunteer in figure skating activities that represent the Skating Club of Natick for a minimum of sixteen (16) hours in total over the four (4) most recent years. Volunteer hours may be earned at group lesson sessions.
7. Scholarship amounts will be determined by the availability of scholarship funds and the number of qualified applicants.
8. Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the Board of Directors of the Skating Club of Natick.
9. Applicant must complete the required Scholarship Application and submit the application and other required forms by the posted deadline in order to be considered for a scholarship. **Late applications will not be accepted.**
10. Applications must be postmarked by March 31st and mailed to the Skating Club of Natick's mailing address as indicated on the Scholarship Application.
11. The Scholarship Application includes the application, 2 letters of recommendation and proof of hours of volunteer service for the Skating Club of Natick.
12. All selections are considered final. All applications and attachments become the property of the Skating Club of Natick.

The Skating Club of Natick (SCON) does not discriminate in academic scholarship selection on the basis of age, sex, religion, marital status, etc.
